Drummer Willy Wiegler also contributes to the group's songwriting giving Brickyard a distinct advantage and diversity in the creative process. Inject the steady rumble of bassist Bernie Rozmovits and raucous saxophone of Tom Hoctor and the Brickyard Blues package is a tidy blues outfit capable of delivering with style and grace. Check out the band's tribute to the late, great K.D. Bell on the song "Alabama Blues Man." The album's title track "Naughty" is also a highlight on this well played and recorded album.

Brickyard Blues is not just another blues band. Sure, they play blues like B.B. King, Albert King, T-Bone Walker, Buddy Guy, and Stevie Ray Vaughan. But they also add classic dance tunes from the Motown and Stax record labels, as well as R&B favorites as recorded by the Blues Brothers and The Commitments. The group even mixes it up with the hot rod energy of Brian Setzer and Eddie Cochran. In addition, they perform original tunes that range from jazzy ballads to outright rockers. It's the blues plus a whole lot more. They get audiences dancing, covering styles from the Chicago blues of Muddy Waters, to the Memphis style of B.B. King, to the Texas shuffle of Stevie Ray, to the soulful Stax sound of Sam & Dave.
